



Assistant Authorization

I understand that the submission process involves furnishing a copy of my material, as well as providing information, making choices, and signing an Author Agreement. I recognize that other information, including an FAQ, is available on the Repository website.

I authorize each Assistant to act for me in submitting material to the Repository, including signing Author Agreements on my behalf and taking any other action for me in connection with the Repository, with the same effect as if I had taken those actions myself.

Use the FAS OA Author's Agreement option if the item is subject to the FAS Open Access Policy and you have not received and are not seeking a waiver for the article under the policy. Use the Standard Author's Agreement if the item is not subject to the FAS Open Access Policy or you have received or are seeking a waiver for the article under the policy.

FAS OA Author Agreement

I direct that the work I am depositing (the "Work") be stored and made available publicly in Harvard's open access repository, as it may evolve (the "Repository").

I confirm my grant to the President and Fellows of Harvard College ("Harvard") of a non-exclusive license with respect to my scholarly articles, including the Work, as set forth in the policy adopted by the Faculty of Arts and Sciences on February 12, 2008, a copy of which can be found at <http://hul.harvard.edu/osc.html>. Accordingly, Harvard may exercise any and all rights under copyright relating to the Work, in any medium, and may authorize others to do the same, provided that the Work is not sold for a profit.

I represent and warrant to Harvard that:

- I have the right to grant Harvard the rights described above and to deposit the Work in the Repository.
- The Work does not infringe or violate any copyright or other rights of a publisher or any other party. Distribution of the Work by Harvard or others as permitted above will not infringe or violate any such rights.
- If the Work contains any material for which I do not hold copyright, I have obtained all rights necessary to allow the Work, including that material, to be distributed and made available by Harvard or others as permitted above.
- If the Work is based upon work that has been sponsored or supported by an agency or organization other than Harvard, any right of review or other such obligations of the sponsorship or support agreement have been fulfilled.

Standard Author Agreement

I direct that the work I am depositing (the "Work") be stored and made available publicly in Harvard's open access repository, as it may evolve (the "Repository").

I grant to the President and Fellows of Harvard College ("Harvard") the non-exclusive right to preserve and reproduce the Work, and to display, distribute and make the Work available publicly without charge from the Repository, in any format.
